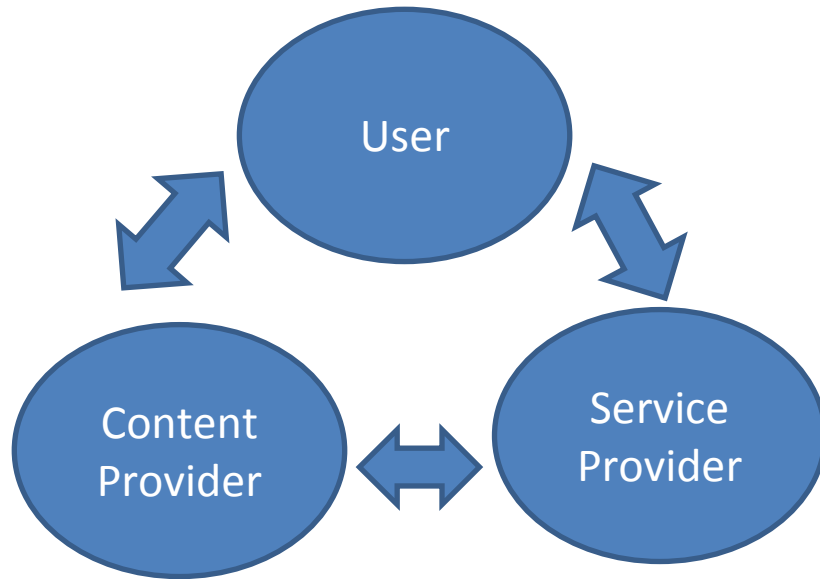

# Networks
